Last year we were granted a Volunteer Grant for purchase of first aid box, first aid training and a defibrillator pack. We now have made all the purchases and booked a qualified trainer. The defib will be placed in the kitchen area next to the fridge and the first aid will be a bright green box above the fridge cupboard.

We have a trainer coming to our club Saturday 24th March and training four of us for first aid. The trainer is also there on the day to give a 20minute presentation on how to use the defibrillator.

The defibrillator does save lives and if you want an information session on how the defib works, I encourage to come down for the 20minutes session.. We have booked the trainer so that any member in our club can feel at ease and ask questions. He is there for us and to teach us how to use the defib machine.
