Congratulations Keith Richards on becoming our new President.

Keith was born in England and his parents moved to Adelaide when he was eight years old. Most of Keith's childhood was spent at Lyndoch in the Barossa Valley. He went to Lyndoch Primary School and then Nuriootpa High School. Keith played AFL football for Lyndoch in winter and tennis for the Lyndoch tennis club in summer – juniors on a Saturday morning and seniors in the afternoon, and was captain when the junior tennis team won the Barossa championship. Keith has been a member of the Carlton Football Club for many years, and was able to attend a number of their games this year while they were based in Queensland.

After high school Keith moved to the southern suburbs of Adelaide to attend Flinders University where he completed a Bachelor of Economics Degree. As coincidence would have it, Keith lived in the next suburb (Eden Hills) to Richard and Jenny Mottershead (Blackwood) for two years without knowing it. Eden Hills in the Adelaide hills had cold winters, and Keith used to laugh at the nightly weather reports when it was minus seven degrees in Canberra thinking "that's all they deserve", little realising that he would soon be moving to Canberra when university was finished.

Keith Joined the Australian Bureau of Statistics in Canberra in February 1982 as a Graduate Economist, then moved to the ACT Treasury for five years, then back to the Commonwealth Government until he retired in February 2015. Keith moved to Nambour in January 2019.

In 1989 Keith met his wife Maribel, and they married in 1991 at Davao City on the island of Mindanao in the Philippines. They have three children – Krissabelle who works in IT in Canberra, Kevin who works in hospitality on the Sunshine Coast and Andrew who is studying at TAFE on the Sunshine Coast.

Keith stopped playing tennis during high school, but used to go Melbourne regularly for the Australian Open during his working life, and after he finished working joined the local Jerrabomberra Tennis Club and started playing again, and his son Andrew also started playing.

When Keith moved to Nambour he went to Nambour Tennis Club on Washington Street, a few streets away from where he lives, but whenever he went there it was either closed or very busy, so he drove over to Nambas, spoke with Richard who was sweeping court 4 for the Saturday lunchtime social tennis, came back the next day and was assessed by Linda as 'suitable standard' and the rest is history.

Ken Dusting's coaching agreement was agreed as follows:

- Ken is granted the right to coach on the courts for payment of \$20 per week;
- Ken is not required to pay playing fees at club social tennis sessions;
- Ken is not required to maintain the gardens; and
- Ken's coaching fees will not change - \$50 for members and immediate family members and \$55 for non-members. This does not apply to group coaching sessions, and coaching fees are to be displayed within the clubhouse.

Honoraria were unchanged for 2021 - \$500 for the President, Secretary and Treasurer and \$150 for the Technical Officer.

Club Captain Appointed

Yanni Stefanidakis was appointed Nambas Club Captain at the 2020 Annual General Meeting. Yanni will be responsible for the selection and nomination of Nambas Fixtures and Veterans teams for 2021. In the past there was no consistent process for choosing Nambas representative teams, so a new Management Committee position was created to bring fairness and accountability to the selection process. Yanni will take into account members tennis ability, and be able to consider other factors such as availability, personality and the make-up of current teams that have been together for a long time.

Recipe for November 4 Ingredients– Vanilla Slice



Vanilla Slice

- **200g packet Lattice biscuits** any flat-square biscuit will work
- **600 ml cream**
- **100g packet Vanilla Pudding mix**

Passionfruit Icing

- **1 cup icing sugar**
- **2 passionfruit pulp**
- **1 tablespoon butter** softened

Instructions

1. Line a 20 x 30cm lasagna dish with baking paper.
2. Layer with 8 Lattice biscuits flat side up.
3. In a bowl, using electric beaters, mix cream and pudding until thick.
4. Spoon the creamy mixture over the biscuit base.
5. Top with another layer of biscuits, shiny side up.
6. Refrigerate for at least 30 minutes before topping with passionfruit icing.
7. To make the icing, mix together the icing sugar, passionfruit and butter until an even spreadable consistency is reached. Add more passionfruit if required.
